An Office Memorandum no. F. No. 15(2)/2001-DPE(GM) dtd. 29.07.2024 on Consolidated & revised Guidelines
regarding Vigilance Policy for CPSEs has been issued by Department of Public Enterprises [DPE]. The same is
being shared herewith. Three critical para(s) are being highlighted here in verbatim. All may take a note of
these for information & to act accordingly.

Para 4.1	Vigilance Clearance may be denied to an officer if he fails to submit his annual Immovable Property Return of the previous year latest by 31 st January of the following year
Para 4.2	Vigilance Clearance will not normally be granted for a period of three years after the currency of the punishment if a minor penalty has been imposed on an officer.
Para 4.2	In case of imposition of a major penalty, vigilance clearance will not normally be granted for a period of five years, after the currency of the punishment. During the period, the performance of the officer should be closely watched.
